## 2017 WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP RECAP

The 2017 IHMSA World Championship held at the Oklahoma City Gun Club July 14th thru the 22nd was a total success with entries nearing the 500 mark.

Weather conditions were a little on the warm side with temperatures averaging around 94 degrees for the 9 days of the event. However, wind conditions for the entire match were on the calm side as the attached scores indicate.

With a new 12 foot apron on the back side of our 403 ft. firing line, spotters & spectators were in the shade from morning into the late afternoon.

As normal, shooters from as far away as Australia (pictured right) were in attendance and were greeted by a new air-conditioned reloading facility (pictured left) recently completed. They took full advantage by reloading many rounds of their favorite calibers to be shot in this match. We certainly appreciate our overseas shooters for traveling great distances to shoot in our fantastic sport of handgun silhouette competition.

Some of the highlights of the match included a couple of world records set by Scott Thompson, Mustang, OK, who shot the first ever 80x80 UFS (1/5 scale open) in World Championship competition & followed that up with an 80x80 in UASFS (1/5 scale scope) for a record 1/5 scale 160 aggregate score, great shooting Scott.

Linda Lanning, Atwood, KS, won both high lady in BB-UAS as well as SB-UAS with an 80x80 in each, great shooting Linda.

Another accomplishment was Steve Martens, our IHMSA president who shot a UAS 40x40 in the ULTRA 500 match &

followed that up with a 34x40 in Unlimited for a 74x80 aggregate score.

Another highlight for our match, we had eight (8) junior shooters ranging in age from 9 to 16 who competed in this match & a couple of them shot 80x80's, great shooting guys & gals.

With low wind & excellent lighting conditions all week we had a total of sixty-nine (69) 80x80's & a 40x40 in ULTRA 500 plus four (4) 40x40's in AIR competition. WOW!!

A proposal was presented to the IHMSA board during this match to allow reflex (red dot) sights on production guns including BB & SB to shooters over the IHMSA senior age limit of 60, with an allowance of 4 extra ounces of added weight to production guns which include revolvers. This proposal was approved for a one (1) year trial time period beginning January 1st, 2018.

The 2018 IHMSA World Championship, for the fifth time in six years, again will be held here at the Oklahoma City Gun Club, tentative dates are set for July 13th thru the 21st. Make plans to attend that one for sure.

## SMALLBORE FIFTH SCALE RECORDS

The photo on the left shows the two guns that Scott Thompson used to set the smallbore fifth scale records at the 2017 World Championship.

For Unlimited Any-Sight Fifth Scale he shoots a 10" Anschutz Exemplar with the factory barrel. Mounted to the end of the barrel is a homemade barrel weight that increases the overall weight to be 0.4 pounds below the weight limit. The barrel is drilled and tapped for a TC Contender scope mount which holds a Nikon Buckmaster 6-18 power scope with side focus. The bottom of the grip was cut to remove about one inch to aid in shooting from the Fields Flop position. The ammunition used is SK Standard Plus.

In the Unlimited Fifth Scale class Scott shoots a 14" Anschutz Exemplar with the factory barrel and SK Standard Plus ammunition. Another homemade barrel weight was added to similarly increase the weight to be 0.4 pounds below the limit. The sights are Anschutz peep-on-peep with a .031 aperture in the front. Again, roughly one inch was removed from the rear grip for shooting in the Fields Flop position.

## 500 METER REPORT

In 2017 for the second time the IHMSA World Championships were accompanied by a 500 meter match on the day after the regular shoot offs and awards. This year's match will be known in infamy as the Match of the Evil Potato Salad. Those of you who were at the burger dinner graciously prepared by Diane Richards, Thank You, Diane, and who ate some of the potato salad left over from the banquet will know what I am talking about. Those of you who were not there do not want to know the unfortunate details. Suffice it to say that in the future we need to be as safety oriented toward the marvels of modern refrigeration as we are toward gun safety.

This year our President, Steve Martens, asserted full dominance at the 500 meter match. He won both Iron Sights with a 34x40 and Any Sight with a 40x40. This 40 is his fourth which puts him at the top of the list of those who have shot 40x40 in Any Sight 500 meter matches. No one else has more than two. This gave him an aggregate of 74x80 which officially becomes the Aggregate Record for 500 meter shooting. The rest of us would just as soon forget about our scores so they will not be mentioned here.

As most of you know, the Old Guy has been trying to get all IHMSA Big Bore categories sanctioned in 500 meter shooting all the way back to when Elgin was President and the Old Guy was merely the Middle Aged Guy. Last year we took a substantial step in this direction when IHMSA agreed to do a two year trial sanction of Unlimited Iron Sight and Unlimited Any Sight

categories for 500 meter shooting. This trial has gone favorably so far, and the Board of Directors has agreed to do a sort of a trial of a trial of the remaining old ULTRA (Ultra Long Target Range Association, the former non governing body which sort of sanctioned all kinds of 500 meter handgun shooting) categories. These categories are Production, Revolver, Standing, Standing Any Sight, Half-Size and Half Size Any Sight. Lest you think this is absurd, be aware that the former ULTRA records for Production are 32x40 with an IHMSA legal Production Pistol and 34x40 with an NRA Conventional Pistol. The Revolver record is 24x40. The Iron Sight 500 meter Half Size record is 30x40, and the Any Sight 500 meter Half size record also is 30x40. I have forgotten what the Standing and Standing Any Sight records are, but there are records dating back into the 1980s. Iron Sight got into double digits, and Any Sight was not far from 20.

This trial of a trial is not quite a trial sanction. The way we are going to do this is you folks are going to shoot 500 meter scores in as many of these categories as you like, and you are going to email the scores to me. I will report them in this column, and if a lot of people participate, it is possible that this trial of a trial will lead to an actual trial sanction. To steal a phrase from the old days, "Let's Shoot Silhouettes... that are really far away."

You say you don't have access to a 500 meter range but you want the same challenge as 500 meter silhouette shooting. Try putting your .22 silhouettes out at big bore distances. One of the great achievements in silhouette shooting history is Dean Grua's 40x40 on .22 targets at Big Bore distances with an iron sighted .22. As far as I know, no one else has done better than 36x40.





## THE NEW SILHOUETTER

Since their development, there have been tomes of materials devoted to explaining the differences between 223 Remington and 5.56 NATO. While “blah-blah-blah-gers” like to run the ink despite minimum knowledge, more astute articles pretty much agree on most issues. While the external dimension of the cartridge cases are the same, the 5.56 NATO is loaded to higher pressures and velocity. To accomplish this, there may be more powder, different powder or the internal capacity of the case may be smaller due to thicker brass.

At the same time, the chambers for the two cases are different as well, the 223 Remington being tighter and having less leade. For reliability, it certainly makes sense for the military cartridge/rifle to be more forgiving, even at the expense of a bit of accuracy advantage for the 223 Remington. The consensus is that 5.56 NATO should not be fired in a rifle designated for 223 Remington. See also “SAAMI TECHNICAL DATA SHEET UNSAFE FIREARM-AMMUNITION COMBINATIONS,” (Revised 3/24/17), where it states that 5.56 NATO should not be fired in rifles chambered for 223 Remington.

While there are challenges as to the dangers involved, it is certainly prudent to be conservative and avoid any situation where knowledgeable people and manufacturers recommend against something. If you challenge their authoritative advice and you are right, what’s the upside? On the other hand, if you’re wrong, you can imagine that the downside can be severe. That said, can the two rounds be interchanged in any situation?

The basic differences between the chambers is in the leade (sometimes written as lead) which is the freebore section of the barrel before the rifling. In the .223 Remington, the diameter of the leade is tight and its length is short. In the 5.56 NATO, the leade is relatively wider and longer. That extra space accommodates the higher pressure of the 5.56 NATO cartridge, but if that cartridge is put into a .223 Remington chamber with a smaller leade, that extra pressure has nowhere to go so it builds to a potentially dangerous level. The bottom line is not to fire .223 Remington in any barrel or gun specifically labeled for just the .223 Remington.

How about the other way? Can .223 Remington be fired in a 5.56 NATO chamber? The short answer is yes, but why do it? Accuracy will suffer over what you would get out of a properly chambered .223 Remington rifle. This is especially true if you fire the ubiquitous 55 grain loads so common on the market. The 5.56 NATO typically sports a 62 grain bullet.

Enter the Wylde chambering which claims to shoot both cartridges with near identical accuracy. How does it perform this magic trick? Essentially, the diameter of the leade is tight and the length of the freebore is long. By controlling the bullet so that it engages the rifling without yaw, accuracy is enhanced, while the pressure spike is mitigated by the additional space created by the length of the leade. Nice trick!

So when looking to test some of Hornady’s new Black in both 223 Remington and 5.56 NATO, I cautiously examined my options for what platform to use. Keep in mind that the “Black” portion of the name refers to so-called black guns or what have come to be known as modern sporting rifles (MSRs). The

Black ammunition line marketing materials indicate that these offerings were developed for optimal performance in black guns. Nevertheless, I looked at some other platform options as well. I quickly discounted my Ruger Mini-14 Ranch rifle that’s a lot of fun to shoot, but clearly only intended for 223 Remington. Besides, while handy and fun, its wispy barrel does not lend itself to great accuracy.

I also considered my Thompson Center Encore 223 Remington rifle barrel. Ideas spun in my head about how strong the action was and that cartridges much more intense than what I was considering were handled with aplomb by the Encore’s tough frame. Over the years, I had even witnessed some shooters who had used stupid loads in their Encores receiving no long-term injurious effects from such ill-advised activities. Nevertheless, being conservative and practicing what I preach I decided not to use the Encore.

As expected, my Bushmaster AR-15 turned out to be the correct vehicle for tossing bullets from both cartridges. According to Bushmaster, “All Bushmaster rifles are chambered to accept 5.56mm ammunition and always have been. The NATO Spec 5.56mm chambers have a longer “leade” or throat than the SAAMI Spec .223 caliber chambers which have about half of the leade or throat of the 5.56mm chambering. While it is safe to fire both 5.56mm and .223 caliber ammunition in our rifles, the 5.56mm ammunition should not be fired in rifles chambered in .223 caliber as they will develop very high pressures.” Note the “safe...in our rifle...(emphasis added). Besides, my rifle is clearly marked “CAL 223-5.56MM” confirming that the manufacturer considers it safe to fire both rounds.

Just for the heck of it, I contacted Bushmaster to inquire as to whether or not I had a Wylde chambering, receiving an emphatic negative response. Here’s is the dialog: First, from me to Bushmaster, “I’m curious about the chambering in my Bushmaster AR-15 (XM15-E2S). I know it can fire both .223 Remington and 5.56mm NATO, but is the chambering for the 5.56 NATO or is it a Wylde chambering? Or something else? Thank you for your help and info.” Now the response: “Ken, Our rifles are going to be 5.56 chamber. We do not do any Wylde chambers on our rifles. Thank you and best regards, Bushmaster Consumer Services.”

When first examining the two Hornady loadings, the appearance is similar. The overall dimensions are the same and both the 223 Remington and the 5.56 NATO sported the same 62 grain FMJ. The head, on the other hand, immediately shouted out some differences. Obviously, the headstamps were different. Further, the NATO round had a typical military crimped and



sealed primer. “Ughh,” I said to myself as I thought of how I do not like to swage military crimps when I reload. Oh well.

Weighing samples of each factory loaded cartridge gave me an average of 181.4 grains for the 223 Remington and 180.8 grains for the 5.56mm NATO. Pulling the bullets and powder from another group of samples gave me an average weight of the case and primer as 93.9 for the 223 Remington and 91.7 grains for the 5.56 NATO. This surprised me. I thought that the 5.56 case would be thicker and hence, heavier. I checked more cases to make sure I wasn't hitting an anomaly and kept checking but this weight difference going the wrong way from my intuition is a mystery to me.

The powders looked very much the same to me, being ball in both cases, the 223 weighing an average of 25.7 grains from the samples I pulled; the powder from the 5.56 NATO weighing 26.2 grains. In all my weighing, there was very little variation, indicating good QC at the manufacturing level (no surprises there).

Killing cartridges by pulling them apart is nowhere near as satisfying as firing them at the range, so off I went. I did not bother to bring my chronograph since relative speed is not important for me when punching paper at 100 and 200 yards. Hornady publishes 2751 fps. and 2714 fps. from a 24” test barrel at 100 yards. Interestingly, the 37 fps. spread only drops to 26fps. out at 500 yards, a distance I never shoot. When sighted out to 200 yards, Hornady's projected trajectories for the two loads are the same, only beginning to differ slightly after that and spreading to 1-1/2” at 500 yards. The nominal drop for each load at that point is about 4 feet so a 1-1/2” difference is relatively very minor. While the preceding is of intellectual interest, as a practical matter, since I shoot CMP at 200 yards with a 16-1/2” barrel (about only 2/3 of the length of Hornady's test barrel), the numbers will drop. For 100 yard test purposes, I estimate that both loads are somewhere in the 2500+/-fps. neighborhood or thereabouts.

Some years ago I picked up a Leupold AR-15 scope base that fits in the slot of the carry-handle atop my Bushmaster rifle. I did not bother to re-zero the point of impact for the high scope as I was only looking for groups. My competition shooting is done with the A-2 rear sight of the rifle which was not disturbed during my testing. Not surprising, my scoped and benchrested groups were spectacular compared with my typical CMP match groups. Neither Hornady load disappointed and I had several sub-MOA groups with both Remington 223 and 5.56 NATO. Besides the usual 5 shot groups, I shot a few 10 shot groups using 5 of each loading. The general point of impact was the same; no group of 10 was over two inches except for one which was completely shooter error, and the best was just under 1-1/4”.

Removing the scope and shooting two groups each off the bench with the same aperture rear that I use for matches, the groups certainly opened up a bit due to my own peeper deficiencies but that's no fault of the ammo. The Hornady loads do their part much better than I do mine. Of note, out of my Bushmaster, both loads performed about the same, with no discernible advantage to either. That said, I'd give a slight nod to the 223 Remington for two reasons: First, the 5.56 NATO sells for about 10% more; second, the absence of a crimped primer will facilitate reloading. However, I would not hesitate to

buy and use either. The real issue will be availability. Although available online, as of now, none of a small handful of shops I frequent has had the Hornady Black in stock. I'll be checking for it at my next gun show. Hopefully, I'll be able to stock up on one or both loads.

Currently, the Hornady Black line has loadings for 6.5mm Creedmoor, 5.45mm x 39, 6.5mm Grendel, 6.8mm SPC and 300 Blackout.
